



Code of Conduct: Players & Parents / Guardians

2020 PLAYING SEASON

As a player or member¹ of the New Westminster Minor Lacrosse Association we commit to the following and understand that as a player or parent / guardian we may be subject to discipline that may include removal from the game, practice, or facility, and, depending on the severity of the action, possible suspension or expulsion from the association, should any of the following commitments be broken:

Player:

- I will participate in all games, practices and team events as often as I am able and **in a positive, respectful way.**
- I will **wear the Salmonbellies uniform with pride** (game shorts, jerseys) and treat it with the respect it deserves. Jerseys will be brought to and from games on a hanger.
- **I will not smoke or vape** at any event where I am representing NWMLA; this includes games (home and away), practices, clinics, tournaments, parades etc.

Players and Parents /Guardian(s):

- I will demonstrate courtesy and respect for all players, spectators, officials, and coaches **regardless of association.**
- I commit to not swear, or use foul or negative language.
- I will always represent New Westminster Minor Lacrosse in a **positive, respectful way.**
- I will **not verbally or physically abuse a game official.**
- I (and our guest(s)) will show respect and courtesy by demonstrating **positive support** to all players, coaches, officials and spectators at every game, practice or other sporting event, regardless of association and **not to engage in any kind of unsportsmanlike conduct** such as booing and taunting; refusing to shake hands; or using profane language or gestures.
